Artwalk in the Park

The Park will hold their fourth annual Art Walk in the Park on August 27th from 9am to 4pm. Last year's event exceeded expectations with an estimated 2,000 attendees and over 60 craft and food vendors on August 28th. Vendors and visitors traveled from as far as Rochester, NY.

Keeping with tradition, The Park will hold "Run the Park" on the morning of the event.

"Run the Park" 5K

The "Run the Park" trail run/hike is a challenging course within the woods of Powell Stackhouse Park. Portions of the course are technical (rocky and rooted). All participants who pre-registered 2 weeks prior to the event are guaranteed a race item.

This year's race will take place on Saturday, August 26th, at 8:30 am. Participants can begin registering and picking up their packets as early as 7:30 am at the Luzerne St. entrance. All proceeds from the event will go towards planned improvements at The Park.

Board Member, Denise Urban, will host the Saturday, August 5th hike starting at 10am at the Spangler Pavilion. Participants will get a preview of Art Walk in the Park, which will be held along the Tioga Trail later in the month, on August 27th. Each hiker will have the opportunity to start their own nature journal during the hike. A handmade journal will be available to the first 20 hikers.





Art in the Park

Each Thursday through the summer, The Park will host free art and social skill activities for young children. While the event is geared toward elementary youth, all ages are welcome to attend.

The June 22nd event hosted 11 children where they read a short story and reflected on it, and then participated in a craft that related to the story's theme.

There will be two sessions held at each end of the Park. Westmont end starts at 10:00 am at the Spangler Pavilion, while the Lower Yoder/West End Entrance will start at 11:30 am.
